Requires FOCUS!

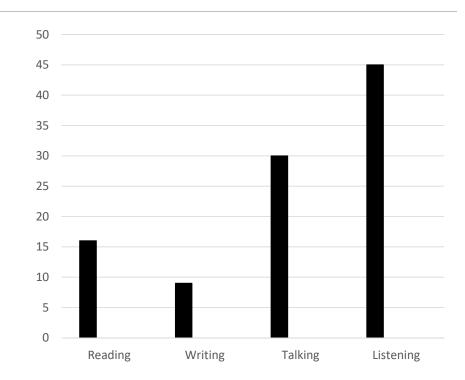
Quickly glance at the letters and numbers that I am about to show you.

Communication Statistics

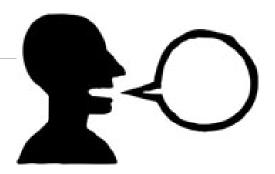
70% of our time is spent communicating with others.

Did you know?!

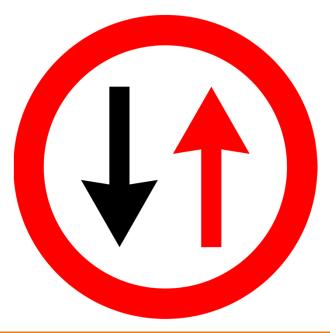


When you are working one-on-one with someone your breathing and heart rate sync up?



Communication is a 2-Way Street

Interpersonal Communication is a process:



Sender: Send message

Receiver: Hears and responds

Sender: Clarifies

Receiver: confirms



Recipe for Communication of the Purpeople.

7% of what we communicate is based on vocabulary and word choice

38% of what we communicate is based on voice inflection 55% based on non-verbal behavior

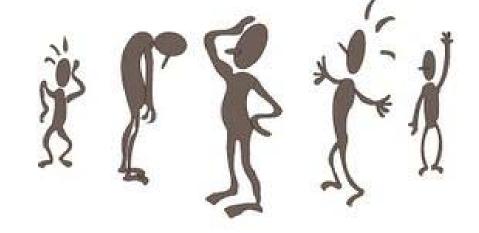

Lead by Example

- Make Important Observations
- Practice Active Listening
- Lead by Example
- Practice Reflective Listening
- Become an expert in Non-Verbal Communication



Mind & Spirit

- Make Important (Internal) Observations
- Align Your Communication with Your Intention
- Commit to Being Fully Present
- Withhold Judgment while Listening
- Ask Clarifying Questions
- Practice Empathy Do No Harm

- Actions Speak Louder than Words
- Get Out in Front Clear a Path
- Measure what Matters
- Lead in Service of Others
- Jump in and Help
